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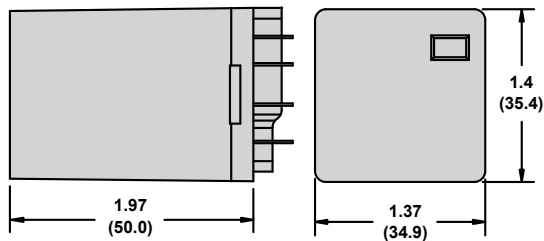

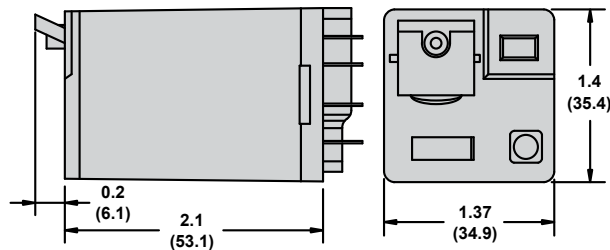

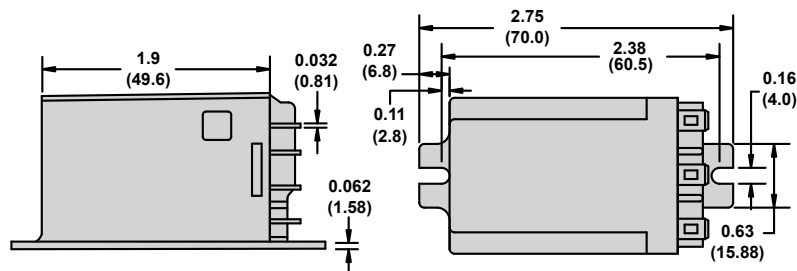
Plain Cover Dimensions



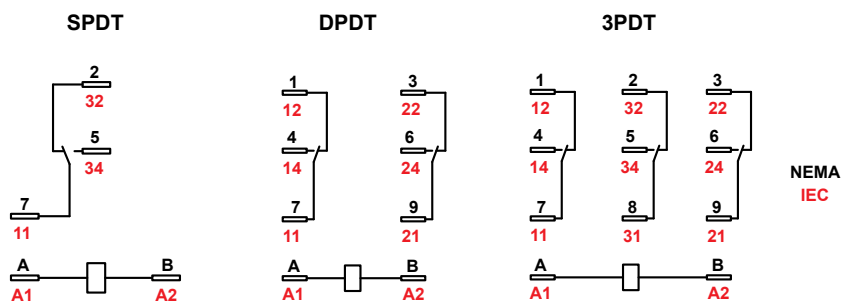
Full-Feature Cover Dimensions



Top Flange Cover Dimensions - Code C1

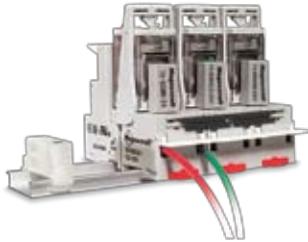

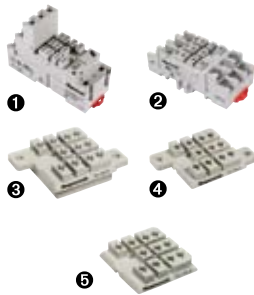
